#### **Job Purpose**

To assist in planning and delivering a range of activities suitable for primary age children

# The key responsibilities of this post will include:

- 1. To assist in the delivery and supervision of children's activities ensuring a high level service is provided.
- 2. To assist in the planning and preparation of activities for these schemes ensuring that activities are delivered in a safe manner.
- 3. Complete a daily evaluation of the schemes and activities provided.
- 4. Work with the Coordinator to plan daily and weekly activities.
- 5. Attend to the personal care needs of the young people as required and provide the highest standards of care to all children in a safe and stimulating environment.
- 6. To develop and maintain good relationships and communications with parents and carers.
- 7. Participate in regular meetings with After School Club staff/Coordinator and/or Head Teacher to address issues related to service provision
- 8. Such other responsibilities allocated which are appropriate to the grade of the post.
- 9. To prepare resources and set up activities before children arrive at club.
- 10. To make snack, clear away snack including loading and unloading the dishwasher.
