- Able to deal effectively with difficult situations within groups and between individuals and agencies
- Training or relevant experience of working with children and families
- Knowledge of child development
- Car driver with use of a car

- Knowledge and understanding of difficulties faced by families under stress
- Commitment to personal development
- Knowledge of issues relating to family support
- Knowledge and understanding of child protection issues
- Awareness of legislation and policy impacting on families
- Ability to communicate clearly and effectively
- Commitment to providing a quality service to all service users and customers
- Experience of working within tight timescales with a heavy and varied workload whilst being detail conscious
- Ability to work on own initiative and as part of a team
- Commitment to Equal Opportunities and anti-discrimination practice in employment and service delivery
