## **Job Description**



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Post Title: Plasterer

Responsible to: Contract Manager

**Job Purpose:** To provide technical trade expertise whilst assisting in the

provision of building maintenance and new construction

projects.

Main Duties: The following is typical of the duties the postholder will be

expected to perform. It is not necessarily exhaustive and other duties of a similar nature and level may be required

from time to time.

- (1) To undertake a range of plastering tasks including repair, removal and replacement of defective plaster products, tiling, dry lining, internal and external including rendering.
- (2) To plaster newly constructed buildings, walls, and ceilings on metal and wood lath, tile, and brick, using two and three coat techniques.
- (3) To patch old plaster, remove loose plaster, cut out cracks, and applies new plaster.
- (4) To undertake lath work necessary to patch holes in walls and ceilings
- (5) To undertake demolition work and site preparatory work.
- (6) To ensure site cleanliness during building work and upon completion of work.
- (7) To use and interpret drawings and specifications in relation to building works.
- (8) Use a variety of construction tools and materials of the plastering trade.
- (9) Transport tools and materials and drive vehicles as required, undertaking the appropriate daily checks and maintaining associated records.
- (10) To receive, process and return work records in relation to building works.
- (11) To provide instruction, advice and guidance to other staff as appointed e.g. apprentices and craft assistants' ensuring work is carried out as instructed.
- (12) Adhere to agreed levels of customer service standards.
- (13) Adhere to agreed levels of productivity.
- (14) To assist in maintaining the Council's environmental policies including EMAS and ISO14001 environmental quality standards.

- (15) To assist in maintaining a healthy, safe and secure environment and to act in accordance with the Council's policies and procedures.
- (16) Promote and implement the Council's equal opportunities in all aspects of employment and service delivery.
