Thank you for expressing an interest in the vacancy for Headteacher at Greenfields Community Primary School. The Governors are seeking to appoint an enthusiastic and inspirational Headteacher who will play a critical role in the continued development of our good school.

Greenfields is a larger than average Primary School with Nursery and Pre-School for children aged from two to eleven years. Located in Wideopen, on the border of Newcastle and Northumberland Local Authorities, and within easy travelling distance of the A1 and A19, we are situated approximately six miles north of Newcastle upon Tyne city centre.

Originally a Middle School, Greenfields Community Primary School first opened in September 1994 and became a Foundation School in 2010, as one of the founding members of the North Tyneside Learning Trust. In 2015, the nursery moved into a separate building and the school expanded its pre-school provision by admitting 2 year olds. Greenfields is well equipped with a large hall and stage, a gym and access to a privately run swimming pool on site. The school also has extensive grounds including 2 large play areas, a vegetable patch, sensory garden and wildlife areas that are all put to effective use as teaching areas. Forest School runs at Greenfields on two afternoons each week, with pupils from nursery through to Year 6 having Forest School sessions during each school year. This has been used as a model of good practice by North Tyneside; it provides high quality curriculum enrichment and an exciting learning experience for all children.

Children generally enter the school with skills and abilities that are broadly typical for their age and go on to make at least good progress during their time with us. In June 2017, HMI noted that "As a result of individualised planning, effective teaching and a stimulating learning environment, children in the early years make strong progress and achieve levels of development above those seen nationally . . . pupils achieved impressive outcomes at KS1, reflecting leaders' commitment to build sustained improvement from the early years upwards. Pupils made good progress at KS2."

Greenfields is an Eco School with Solar PV panel installations. To date we have generated over 60,000 kWh of electricity. Our curriculum reflects our commitment to environmental awareness, sustainability and renewable technologies.

Greenfields has built a reputation for the quality of its teaching, the development of an innovative, enquiry based curriculum, and a demonstrable commitment to sustainability. However, we have been successful in winning many other awards and standards, all of which are evident when walking round the school.

Currently, Greenfields Community Primary School is judged by Ofsted to be a good school. We are looking for an individual who will embrace the challenge, with enthusiasm and purpose, to take us to outstanding.

We enjoy a close working relationship with our partner schools in the North Tyneside Learning Trust, with North Gosforth Academy, where our pupils generally transfer to, as well as the other feeder primary schools in the area.
