Job Purpose

To obtain the skills and knowledge to complete the level 3 Building Services Engineering Craftsperson apprenticeship through the work-based assessment and training college, and install, repair and maintain installations within Gateshead Council building stock.

- 3. To carry out repairs by (fault finding) to domestic & commercial mechanical/plumbing systems and appliances.
- 4. To carry out repairs to hot and cold-water systems, sanitary ware and drainage systems, both domestic and commercial.
- 5. To liaise with tenants/clients with regard to programmes and progress of work.
- 6. To ensure compliance with appropriate specifications and drawings, including inspection, testing and commissioning.
- 7. To have good relationship with customers and be dedicated to the provision of an exceptionally high-quality service.
- 8. To maintain good conduct, attendance and timekeeping, and a good quality of work at all times
- 9. Work as part of a team with other trades in Housing, Compliance and Traded Services.
