Captain Cook Primary School is a part of the James Cook Learning Trust which is a group of 4 primary schools for children aged 3 to 11. At present there are 448 children on roll at Captain Cook Primary School. In addition there is a 39 place Nursery (78 children) which is fully integrated within the Foundation Stage, children attending for half days until the term in which they are 5 before entering Reception.

Foundation and Key Stage 1 pupils are housed within a lower school building in our attractive and extensive grounds. Key Stage 2 children are taught within a second building on the site. We cater for a diverse group of children many of whom arrive at our school through parental choice.

It is our aim to create an atmosphere where mutual respect, caring attitudes and thoughtfulness are encouraged, where each child is respected as an individual and offered appropriate learning opportunities to enable them to fulfil their potential.
