In this instance, the contract of employment would lie with the federation and the successful candidate will be answerable to Governors who represent the interests of both schools as highlighted in the job description and person specification.

0.6FTE time of the post will be allocated to Broomhaugh and 0.4FTE will be allocated to Corbridge. Time will be planned and managed in liaison with the Executive Head Teacher. The post will be a combination of teaching and non-class based management time which will vary annually based on the school development plans and needs of the schools. On appointment, the Deputy will fulfill the role of Early Years Lead at Broomhaugh First School and have a teaching commitment in the Early Years Foundation Stage.

We invite applications from experienced leaders who have a passion for inspiring teaching and learning, and an understanding of small rural church schools. The successful candidate will be an experienced practitioner with extensive knowledge of Early Years as well as Key Stages 1 and 2. This opportunity will enable you to become part of two dedicated school teams working closely with the Executive Head Teacher to ensure both schools continue to thrive.

The suitable candidate will be able to promote our Christian ethos within the school communities and be dedicated to being the best they can be.
