- Demonstrable experience of successfully engaging with external stakeholders and other organisations within the context of project delivery.
- Evidence of collaborative working with internal and external partners.
- Experience of managing risk in the delivery of projects.
- Detailed understanding of project management tools and methodologies
- Experience of analysing complex information from a range of sources
- Experience of producing specifications, project appraisals and implementing financial and output monitoring mechanisms
- Self motivated with the ability to positively influence others
- Ability to work to deadlines and a varying workload with competing demands

### **Desirable**

- Ability to engage effectively with external partners and stakeholder organisations and services
- Experience of developing and implementing communication plans

- Evidence of inclusive approach with the interpersonal skills to support partnership working projects
- Ability to manage resources effectively to achieve project outcomes
- Experience of the effective management of budgets
- Demonstrable experience of a range of delivery models and project procurement routes
- IT Skills including thorough knowledge of MS Office applications and Microsoft Project
- Knowledge of local authority structures and processes
